

## HUNTERSTOUN ACCOMODATION OPTIONS

Nestled in the mistbelt forests of the Amatola Mountains, Hunterstoun is a peaceful, restorative retreat in Hogsback. For over a century, the Wilson (originally Hunter) family has nurtured this land, preserving it as a place of natural beauty and reflection while upholding the ethos of racial equality and social justice inherited from its connections to the Lovedale Mission. Surrounded by waterfalls, rivers, and ancient trees, it offers a haven for nature lovers and is home to the rare and beautiful Cape Parrot and Narina Trogon. Come to reconnect, reflect, and breathe deep in a place that has cared for land and spirit for generations.



### **Kumwamba**

Built of local stone with traditional thatched roofs, Kumwamba is a charming cluster of partially off-grid rondavels and a cottage overlooking the lush Auckland Valley. This self-catering space is ideal for groups or retreats, with each off-grid rondavel offering simple comfort, a shared bathroom, braai area, and a

shared kitchen for communal meals and to charge your devices. The nearby electrified two-roomed cottage offers more privacy, with a bedroom, study, and en suite bathroom. While it has no formal kitchen, it includes a kettle and access to the communal cooking space, on request. Rooted in local heritage and surrounded by birdsong and forest, Kumwamba is best suited for nature lovers, creative writers, and those seeking deep quiet and a back-to-basics connection to place.



### **Rates:**

- *Rondavels* (4 available) – no electricity, no WiFi, shared bathroom & kitchen with electricity to charge devices
  - R530 per night per rondavel for one person, plus R130 per additional guest (a total of 8 people can be accommodated in the 4 rondavels).
- *iStwing Cottage* (bedroom, bathroom, living room) – electricity, no WiFi, shared kitchen
  - R730 per night for single occupancy; R860 for two people

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### **Daaragter**

Perched on the edge of a cliff with sweeping views of the iconic Madonna and Child waterfall, Daaragter offers a front-row seat to one of Hogsback's most breathtaking sights. This three-



bedroom house sleeps up to six guests and includes a bathroom and kitchenette, making it perfect for couples, families or small groups. A freshwater swimming pool set into the expansive lawn completes the sense of escape, inviting you to unwind in total tranquillity. Limited WiFi is available, though you may prefer to unplug entirely.

**Rates:** R1620 per night for up to 3 people, plus R130 per additional guest.

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All stays include access to the surrounding forest, rivers, peace, and bird calls. Rates include a small conservation fee.
